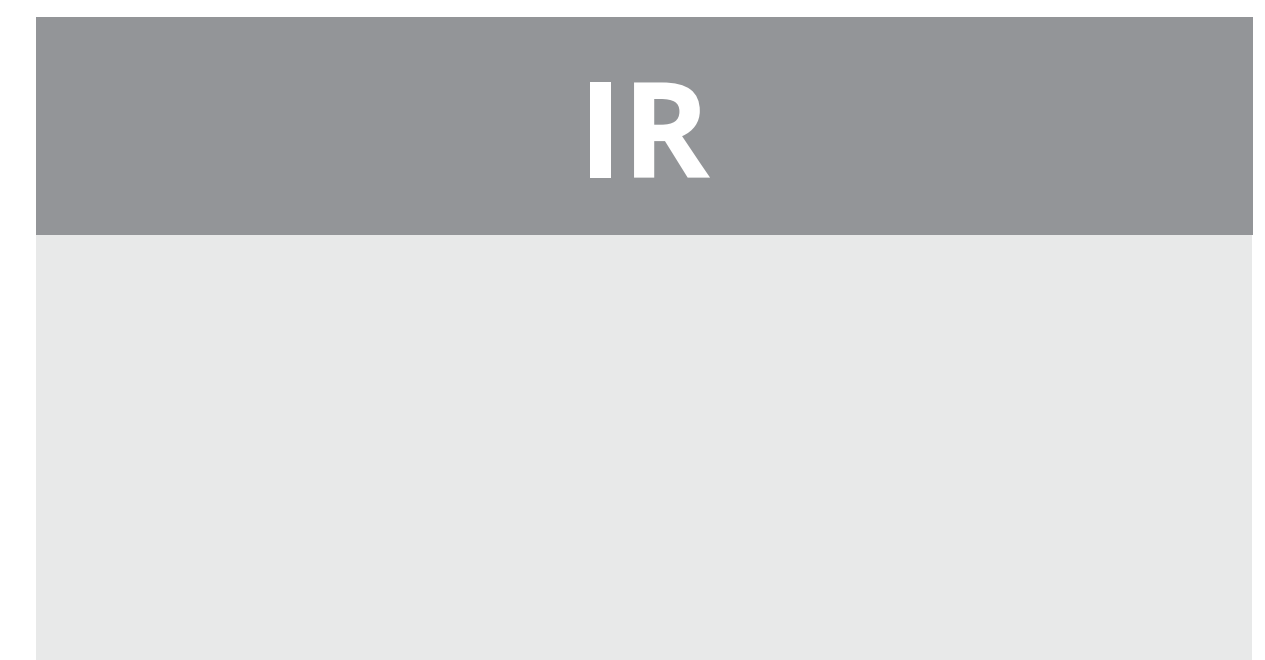
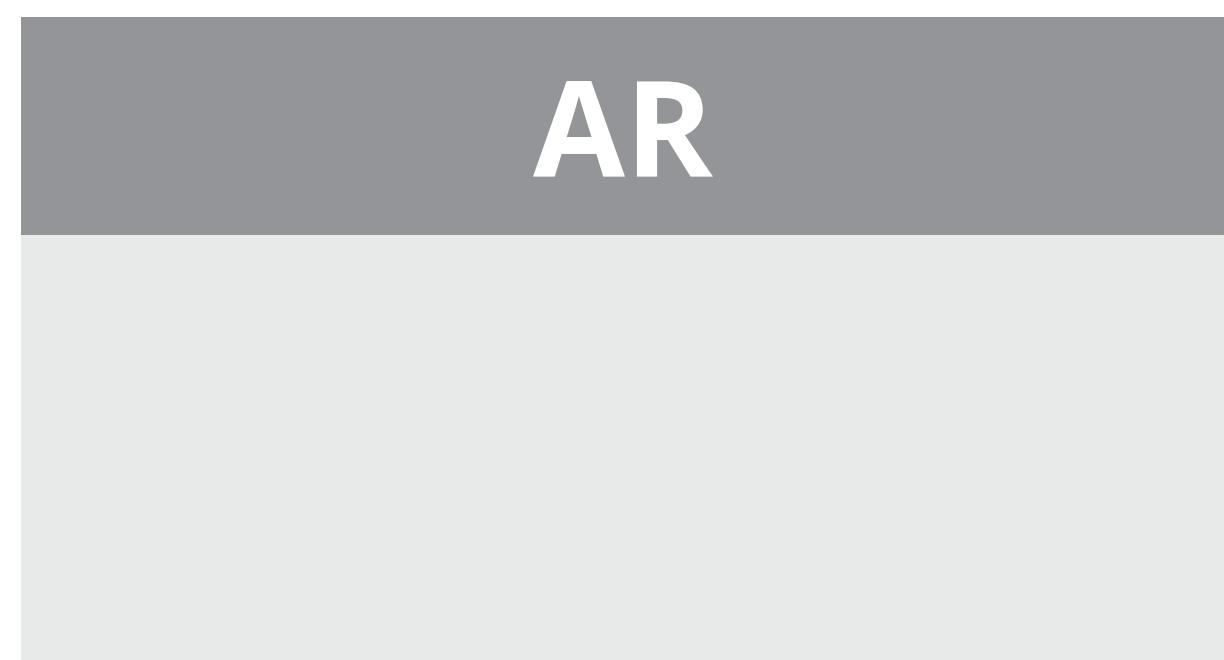


Spanish Verbs

1. In Spanish, all verbs end in 1 of 3 categories.

- trabajar
- vivir
- escribir
- querer
- comer
- amar



2. Each category has its own conjugation pattern.

To conjugate *amar*, drop the -ar ending, and add -o, -as, -ás, -a, -amos, -áis, -an. Use the same logic to conjugate -er and -ir verbs.

PRONOUNS	AMAR	COMER	VIVIR
yo	am o	com o	viv o
tú / vos	am as / am ás	com es / com és	viv es / viv ís
él / ella / usted	am a	com e	viv e
nosotros / as	am amos	com emos	viv imos
vosotros / as	am áis	com éis	viv ís
ellos / as / ustedes	am an	com en	viv en

3. There are regular and irregular Spanish verbs.

REGULAR	IRREGULAR
<p><i>Trabajar</i> and <i>leer</i> are regular verbs. Their stem does not change when conjugated.</p>	<p><i>Ser</i> and <i>querer</i> are irregular verbs. Their stem changes when they are conjugated.</p>
<p>trabaj o le o</p> <p>trabaj as / ás le es / és</p> <p>trabaj a le e</p> <p>trabaj amos le emos</p> <p>trabaj áis le éis</p> <p>trabaj an le en</p>	<p>soy quier o</p> <p>eres / sos quier es / quer és</p> <p>es quier e</p> <p>somos quer emos</p> <p>sois quer éis</p> <p>son quier en</p>
